PERFORMANCE WORK STATEMENT (PWS)
27 AUG 2007**

1.0 MISSION OBJECTIVE. Task Order (T/O) 0001 objective is to provide an analysis for long dwell time Intelligence Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR) support in the Trans-Sahara region of Africa (Algeria, Chad, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Senegal, Nigeria, Tunisia and Libya). The analysis required under this tasks order shall be done in CONUS.

2.0 SCOPE. The DoD Counter Narcoterrorism Technology Program Office (CNTPO) was established to create Counter Narcoterrorism Technology (CNT) networks, infrastructure, and capabilities worldwide that are focused on the detection, identification, and disruption of narcoterrorist activities and organizations. This task effort will support the soldier in the combating of narcoterrorism worldwide. This Performance Work Statement establishes the requirements for the Contractor to provide support in the task area: STUDIES AND ANALYSES (OTHER THAN RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT). This is a firm-fixed price, level-of-effort T/O.

3.0 PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS. The Contractor shall provide an analysis that includes unmanned aerial surveillance or equivalent capability that can provide greater than twelve (12) hours on station time for 5 days a week within a 1,000 nautical mile range of the base of operations. The base of operations needs to be operating 18 hours a day for 5 days a week. If required, the Contractor shall provide services and support 24 hours a day/7 days per week.

3.1 IDENTIFY A SUITABLE PLATFORM AND SENSOR SUITE. The Contractor shall identify a suitable platform and sensor suite to successfully accomplish paragraph 1.0 and the T/O 0001 requirements. The Contractor shall include electro-optic/Infrared (EO/IR), signal intelligence (SIGINT) and communications intelligence (COMINT) in its surveillance methods. The platform must be able to navigate with standard GPS precision.

3.2 DESIGN AND PROVIDE PLANS FOR A BASE OF OPERATION. The Contractor shall design and provide plans for a base of operations to successfully accomplish paragraph 1.0 and T/O 0001 requirements. The base of operations design shall be designed with the capability of being established in remote Trans-Sahara locations if necessary. The daily ISR mission planning will be conducted OCONUS. The base of operations shall be designed to support paragraph 1.0 and T/O 0001 requirements.

3.3 PLAN TO ESTABLISH BASE OF OPERATIONS. The Contractor shall provide plans to establish the base of operations, designed in paragraph 3.2 above, in the Trans-Sahara region as determined by United States European Command (EUCOM).

3.4 PLANS FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF BASE OF OPERATIONS. The Contractor shall provide plans to operate and maintain the base of operations, established in paragraph 3.3 above, as specified by the Technical Monitor (TM).

3.5 PLANS FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF UNMANNED AERIAL SURVEILLANCE OR EQUIVALENT CAPABILITY. The Contractor shall provide a plan to operate and maintain the unmanned aerial surveillance or equivalent capability as specified by the Technical Monitor.

3.6 MISSIONS AND DATA PRODUCTS. The Contractor shall provide a plan to conduct missions and provide data products to identified government and host nation personnel. Data products will be secure and nonsecure. The data products produced from the missions could be classified up to and including Secret. The data products can be processed on the ground after the ISR platform returns at a non-real-time rate.

3.7 LOGISTICS SUPPORT. The Contractor shall provide a plan for the necessary logistics successfully support and accomplish paragraph 1.0 and T/O 0001 requirements.

4.0 OTHER PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

4.1 MEETINGS/BRIEFINGS/PUBLICATIONS. The Contractor shall participate in technical interchange meetings (TIMs), to be scheduled upon request of the responsible contracting officer or written designee, to discuss and to informally evaluate the Contractor's efforts and accomplishments in direct relation to specific T/Os. During these meetings, the Contractor shall present necessary data to enable a joint review of its various assigned tasks, along with attendant schedules, and resource expenditures. The Contractor shall present and participate in technical discussions and shall inform, in a timely fashion, the Technical Monitor of any problems with contract execution and any proposed solutions. The Contractor shall attend and participate in other meetings, as scheduled by the responsible contracting officer or written designee.

4.2 TEMPORARY DUTY (TDY) TRAVEL. The Contractor shall perform temporary duty (TDY) non-local travel, as required in the performance of this T/O, as directed by the TM. The TDY locations include, but are not limited to, various CONUS facilities and various OCONUS locations to include but are not limited to Europe and Africa. All travel required and approved under this T/O will be paid IAW the basic contract by reimbursement to the Contractor. Only required travel previously approved by the TM will be reimbursed under this T/O.

5.0 CONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

5.1 CONTRACTOR PROGRAM MANAGEMENT. The Contractor shall provide the capability to perform a wide variety of tasks related to the requirements described above. The Contractor must be capable of providing flexible, responsive, and high quality management, logistics support and technical support relating to the missions of CNTPO, Combatant Commanders and partner nations associated with counter terrorism and counter narcoterrorism. The Contractor's technical effort shall be under the direction of a TM. The TM shall provide the direction, coordination, and reviews necessary to assure effective task order performance. It is the Contractor's responsibility to provide and maintain a state-of-the-art trained workforce capable of providing the services specified herein. Except as set forth in Section H of the basic contract, all related training, continuing education, certification courses, and other similar events are the financial responsibility of the Contractor.

5.2 WORK HOURS AND LOCATION. The principal place of performance will be the contractor's facilities. The Contractor shall ensure that adequate technical capability is available to provide responses to specific tasks based on a 40-hour work week. The Contractor may be required to provide labor hours in excess of 40 hours per work week to include holiday and weekends, and/or during irregular times and shifts

based upon CNTPO operations and exercises. If required, the Contractor shall provide services and support 24 hours a day/7 days per week.

5.3 CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES. The Contractor shall assume total performance responsibility for work performed and data delivered under this T/O, shall ensure proper management of Subcontractors through analysis, critique, and assessment of the adequacy, timeliness, and cost effectiveness of work performed, and shall adhere to the small business subcontracting plan incorporated into the contract. The Contractor shall identify issues and formulate and provide alternatives for issue resolution.

6.0 SECURITY

Certain Contractor personnel shall be required to access, view, possess, process and/or use classified information, information systems and workspaces to successfully complete certain functions. As specified in the Government basic contract and/or task order labor categories, certain Contractor personnel must possess, and maintain, a SECRET security clearance. In addition, certain Contractor personnel must possess TOP SECRET (TS)/Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI) CLEARANCE access and/or be eligible for immediate adjudication by the cognizant security authority upon award of the task order. Contractor personnel must possess required security clearances at the time a task order management plan proposal is submitted. Future requirements for SCI-eligible personnel or any increased security requirements shall be established by the TM if required during the term of this task order. The Contractor shall submit completed clearance packages within ten (10) calendar days of identification of any increased security requirements.

7.0 DATA REQUIREMENTS.

7.1 TASK ORDER MANAGEMENT PLAN (T/OMP). The Contractor shall provide a task order management plan (T/OMP) that shall define a management system to plan and control the effort under this T/O. The T/OMP must delineate how the Contractor plans to accomplish the effort supporting the specific T/O, to include a breakout of DPPHs, travel, required material, a milestone schedule, and a schedule for the planned expenditure of funds.

7.2 CNTPO OPERATIONS SECURITY (OPSEC) PLAN. The Contractor shall develop and implement a CNTPO OPSEC Plan for control of critical program information, classified material, and sensitive data. The plan, as updated, shall continue to conform to the requirements of the DD Form 1423, DD Form 254 (DoD Contract Security Classification Specification), and further instructions contained in the current Army Regulation 530-1 (Operations Security).

7.3 CONTRACTOR MANPOWER REPORTING. The Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower & Reserve Affairs) operates and maintains a secure Army data collection site where the Contractor will report ALL Contractor manpower (including Subcontractor manpower) required for performance of this contract. The Contractor is required to provide the appropriate information.

8.0 TASK ORDER DELIVERABLES.

9.0 PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE. The period of performance for this task order is for thirty (30) days beginning the effective date of the task order.

10.0 PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES/METRICS:

10.1 This performance-based service T/O incorporates the following performance objectives: (1) customer satisfaction (quality of service); (2) adherence to schedule; (3) efficient and effective cost control and (4) adherence to small business participation goals. It is the Contractor's responsibility to employ the necessary resources to ensure accomplishment of these objectives. The Government's assessment of the Contractor's performance in achieving these objectives will utilize the standards, acceptable quality levels, and surveillance methods described in the Performance Requirements Summary matrix set forth in Appendix A below. The performance incentives will be implemented via the Government's past performance assessment conducted in accordance with Part 42 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), as applicable.

10.2. The performance objectives, standards, and acceptable quality levels shall be applied on a T/O basis on an annual basis. The Government will conduct informal interim counseling sessions with the Contractor's Program Manager to identify any active T/O performance that is not meeting the acceptable quality levels. These sessions will be conducted at least on a quarterly basis in order to provide the Contractor a fair opportunity to improve its performance level.

10.3 The overall performance assessment will also include an assessment of overall Customer Support.

10.4. The Contractor will be notified, in writing, of the Government's determination of its performance level for each performance objective including all instances where the Contractor failed to meet the acceptable quality level.
