1.0 GENERAL: The Contractor shall provide system engineering and technical assistance in the areas of: review of Clean Air Act (CAA) regulations; pollution prevention; and environment management. This effort will focus on support to the NASA MSFC Materials, Processes, and Manufacturing Department in their role as the Principal Center for support of NASA’s review of CAA regulations.

2.0 CLEAN AIR ACT (CAA) REGULATIONS:

2.1 The Contractor shall provide support for review of CAA regulations, including:

2.1.1 Review proposed and final regulations from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to determine potential and/or actual impact to NASA programs.

2.1.2 Determine which NASA Centers and programs will be potentially impacted by proposed rules or rule changes.

2.1.3 Support in issuing calls for information to NASA points of contact.

2.1.4 Collect and consolidate data responses from NASA representatives.

2.1.5 Support regulations and data response discussions among designated NASA representatives.

2.1.6 Develop synopses and internal notices of proposed and final regulations, as requested.

2.1.7 Develop and recommend NASA positions for possible presentation to the EPA.

2.1.8 Support development of comments and recommend consolidation of a NASA response to EPA regulation activity, as required.

2.1.9 Support in representing NASA at EPA CAA regulatory stakeholder meetings and teleconferences, as required.

2.1.10 Support preparation of quarterly status reviews of current and planned CAA regulatory activities.

2.1.11 Support annual assessment of Principal Center activities.

2.1.12 Support development of an Annual Task Plan containing project objectives, deliverables, and schedules required for the CAA regulatory support activities.

2.1.13 Attend meetings and conferences, as directed.

2.1.14 Support preparation for and conduct of meetings and teleconferences, as directed.

2.1.15 Prepare and submit minute of meetings and teleconferences.
