Section C - Descriptions and Specifications

STATEMENT OF WORK

"Special Studies and Analysis Support of Integrated Missile Defense" Statement of Work

1.0 General. The contractor shall provide technical support in Integrated Missile Defense (IMD) for SMDC, MDA, GMD, Joint Functional Component Commander (JFCC) IMD, and STRATCOM in the areas of studies and analyses, software engineering and systems engineering, and integration support. Technical areas include Net Centric Operations, software engineering, Computer Network Operations (CNO), Homeland Security and Modeling and Simulation (M&S). The contractor shall act as integrator for the Government Net Centric, IMD, CNO, Homeland Security, and M&S technology.

1.1 The contractor shall support the analysis, development and integration of Net Centric Operations for IMD and other related activities. This includes secure internet protocol wireless and satellite communications to the Global Information Grid (GIG), Command, Control, Battle Management and Communications (C2BMC), and Defense Enterprise Architecture interface and integration. The contractor shall support trusted web-based application design and evaluation, to include trusted software approaches and anti-tamper implementation. The contractor shall also provide technical support in geospatial, precision Global Positioning System (GPS) (to include anti-jam features) and Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR) supporting technologies.

1.2 The contractor shall support the analysis, development and integration of CNO for IMD and other related activities, to include program protection, physical security, computer network attack and defense. The contractor shall research various computer attack and defense tools and methodologies to support network defense research, and support digital combat exercises to enhance CNO awareness. The contractor shall provide computer attack Red Team support on an as needed basis. The contractor shall also support SMDC's cyber security laboratory with studies, analyses, and engineering and integration support of enterprise-wide network defense/information assurance technologies. This includes validation and verification activities for physical and cyber security techniques/devices. The contractor shall interface with Computer Emergency Response Teams (CERTs) to determine the frequency of attacks detected and the effectiveness of network defense techniques. The contractor shall maintain its awareness of emerging technologies having application to CNO.

1.3 The contractor shall provide analysis, evaluation, development, and integration support of Homeland Security products sponsored by SMDC and other Government agencies. This includes technical support of Homeland Security exercises and demonstrations, including locations outside of Huntsville.

1.4 The contractor shall provide technical support of M&S for IMD and other related activities. Activities shall include studies, analyses, evaluation, development, and integration of wargaming, engineering, engagement, and force-on-force simulations to support IMD users, developers, and testers. The contractor shall provide software engineering support for IMD systems.

1.5 Special Study Support. As tasked by the Technical Monitor, the contractor shall support special study efforts in the areas of Net Centric Operations, IMD, CNO, Homeland Security and M&S. As tasked, the contractor shall define issues and alternatives, develop approaches to the solution of initiatives, and identify program parameters (cost, risk, schedule) associated with the study topic. Results shall be presented in special study report in contractor format.

1.6 The development of software and/or system components is prohibited under this task order.


