Section C - Descriptions and Specifications

SOW

“Tactical Ballistic Missile Trackers: Basic and Advanced” Statement of Work

1.0 BACKGROUND: The Composite Tracker and Classifier (CTC) is a multi-sensor, multi-site tracker that generates a Single Integrated Air Picture (SIAP). The CTC has been successfully demonstrated at both All Service Combat Identification Evaluation Team (ASCIET) 1999 and 2000 exercises, the Joint Combat Identification Evaluation Team (JCIET) 2002, and Roving Sands 2005 with good results. The evolution of this program is to develop a Tactical Ballistic Missile (TBM) capability to complement the current air breathing targets. In order to accomplish this task, the composite tracker needs an additional tracking filter for TBMs in order to maximize performance.

2.0 OBJECTIVE: The objective of this task is to extend the Composite Tracker and Classifier (CTC) target set to Tactical Ballistic Missiles (TBM). Track filters shall be designed and tested* using simulated and (where available) real data to ensure that the best performance is achieved against credible TBM threats.

*** The contractor shall only develop software or code that is incidental to the modeling or simulation of this task order. All other software/code development is prohibited.**

3.0 The contractor shall provide support to AMRDEC’s Applied Sensors, Guidance, and Electronics Directorate as follows:

- 3.1. Model of radar sensor characteristics shall be updated and upgraded.
- 3.2. Credible TBM threats and their operational trajectory and RCS characteristics shall be identified/specified.
- 3.3. Simulation environment shall be specified including atmosphere, wind, earth rotation, gravity and other parameters.
- 3.4. Dynamical models shall be built for TBM threats including aerodynamic, and maneuver characteristics.
- 3.5. Baseline EKF tracker solutions shall be implemented and tested in simulations and against real data, where available
- 3.6. Advanced techniques including bandwidth adaptivity, particle filters and IMM’s shall be implemented and tested to provide improved performance over baseline design
- 3.7. Benefits of disturbance estimation for tracking and impact point prediction shall be implemented and assessed.
- 3.8. Provide the following items:
 - 3.8.1. Matlab codes for selected tracker implementations formatted as function calls with clearly defined inputs, outputs, tuning parameters, and corresponding units
 - 3.8.2. Documentation of tracker equations showing significant derivations and theoretical supporting material
 - 3.8.3. Documentation of test analysis cases; accuracy, consistency and sensitivity performance results
 - 3.8.4. Briefing and briefing chart supplies or Services and Prices
- 3.9 All products resulting from this work will have no restrictions on further use and dissemination once provided to the Government. This will include source code and executable code for any computer software that may be developed under this effort. The documentation of all products will be included in the deliverables to the

government. These products will be delivered under CRDL A004. The contractor agrees not to assert or authorize others to assert any rights or establish any claims to copyright in any copyrightable work first produced, created, generated, or modified under this task order.


