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Section C - Descriptions and Specifications

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“OPERATIONS RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS SUPPORT FOR DAPR-FDA, WARFIGHTING ANALYSIS DIVISION” STATEMENT OF WORK

The contractor shall provide support to the Department of the Army (DAPR-FDA, Warfighting Analysis Division) in the design, execution and reporting of operations research and weapons systems performance analysis studies to support the allocation of Department of the Army resources to competing Army force development activities within the Joint Mission Areas (JMA) of Dominant Maneuver, Precision Engagement, Information Superiority, Full Dimensional Protection, and Focused Logistics.

The contractor will receive direct study tasking from the Chief, DAPR-FDA and will design analyses, identify resources, government support and data requirements to execute the required studies and will submit study plans for government approval.

The contractor will either directly execute approved studies or will represent the Chief, DAPR-FDA in coordinating the use of existing and future analyses to develop integrated assessment which compare the performance and requirements for competing Army program and force structure alternatives. As such, the contractor will design and conduct directed studies to provide detailed assessments of highest return on investment for specified Army systems, comparing and contrasting applicable existing studies in consideration of all available data. In addition, studies will address systems integration across JMAs, and second/third order effects in areas including, but not limited to, the Reserve Component.

In accordance with individual approved study plans the contractor shall:

1. Provide the Department of the Army, DAPR-FDA study reports that compare force performance and resource requirements for Army force development alternatives.
2. Develop procedures, facilities and software to efficiently standardize, repeat and sustain DAPR-FDA force assessment activities.
3. Prepare and present the results of force assessment analyses as required.
4. Provide graphics support as required to support all assigned operations and research analysis efforts throughout the period of performance.

The contractor will provide expertise senior levels as indicated by at least 25 years experience of which 15 years is direct experience in:

1. Design and execution of force-level performance analyses using modeling, simulation and other operations research and weapons systems analysis techniques.
2. Application of decision analysis techniques to develop integrated assessment of multiple, conflicting force performance objectives.
3. Aggregation of findings and data from existing and future studies analysis and demonstrated system performance into integrated systems performance assessments, which include detailed knowledge of sensor to shooter linkages and system of systems interdependencies.
4. Identification, defining and negotiating requirements, assumptions and issues associated in modeling the performance of Army systems in Joint warfighting architectures.

The government (Task Order Monitor) will provide:

1. Study direction and approval of study plans and proposals.
2. Access to required source data, existing studies and analyses.
3. Execution phase oversight of studies and analyses.
