More Continental flights scheduled

Ticket prices come from high fuel costs, minimal population

Several *Hourglass* articles and recent letters discussed flight schedules to and from Kwajalein (both Continental and military) in the wake of Aloha's departure.

Walter B. Dias, staff vice president for Continental Airlines Sales and Marketing, got wind of Kwaj townhall comments and sent me a letter. In his letter he said he was disappointed to hear generalizations made concerning Continental's fare schedule. He wanted to set the record straight. I agree with him, and thought this a good forum to get his very positive message out. Dias said a fourth Island Hopper flight (to operate on Saturdays from July 2 to Sept. 3) should alleviate difficulties experienced by some Kwaj residents anxious for time off the rock. I am still getting inputs, though, from folks frustrated with Kwajalein flight options, costs or both.

He said that in the past 15 years Continental Micronesia has raised fares in Micronesia less than six times, with an average annual fare increases amounting to no more than

4 percent; Kwajalein-to-Honolulu fares have increased only 1.44 percent on an annual basis in this period! He added that Continental has been very sensitive and moderate in their pricing of Micronesia over the years, even in times such as these with fuel costs skyrocketing. Increases in fuel costs in 2004 alone resulted in \$14 million additional costs for Continental. Our remote location also requires Continental to fly with mechanics on board to increase reliability as well as with an additional flight attendant and pilot due to the long duty day.

As with many aspects of life here on Kwaj, there is tremendous overhead involved in supporting our community lifestyle that many of us don't see (and rarely do our personal costs reflect the real costs involved). I know inflation and a host of other problems affecting stateside life can be quickly forgotten here in our little paradise. Living on Kwajalein has many advantages, but a limited airline schedule. We are a small community and our population alone warrants only a few flights a week. And let's face it; we are in the middle of nowhere. This is great when you're staring at a sunset or

heading out in a B-boat – perhaps less so when you're at the Continental office trying to make reservations. Patience is important when planning a departure from Kwajalein or when scheduling to have guests visit, and advance planning is crucial.

Everyone should demonstrate common "Kwajalein courtesy" when making your flight arrangements with the staff of Continental Travel, recognize the special challenges that they face in trying to meet each passenger's needs, and remember that our small and unique population places unusual demands on an airline which is trying hard to provide service to our community. Clearly, we do not have the flight options of a large city in the United States such as Los Angeles or New York; therefore, we must plan early and be flexible in making our travel plans. Meanwhile, we will continue to work closely with Continental Micronesia and the military to improve service, offer competitive prices, and increase flight options during peak travel periods.

Former war zone home to hazards

Last weekend, while underwater, a diver noticed an item that was ceramic looking and thinking it neither an unexploded explosive ordnance nor was dangerous - placed this item in his buoyancy compensator floatation vest pocket. Upon surfacing and entering the dive boat, the diver noticed smoke and fire coming from the BC pocket. The item that was picked up was probably a Japanese grenade containing white phosphorus. Some of the Japanese WWII grenades were made out of pottery and contained white phosphorus. White phosphorus is pyrophoric which means it immediately reacts and ignites when exposed to air.

Fortunately the diver was not seriously injured and Explosive Ordnance Disposal responded.

Continuing education and cautiousness are the keys to UXO accident prevention according to Mike Moore, U.S. Army Kwajalein Atoll Installation Health/Safety officer.

"Our UXO is surface, subsurface and underwater. Within the last two weeks, EOD responded to two grenades, two mortars, and more than 1,500 small arms rounds," he said. He added that an indeterminate number of UXO have been found on and near Kwajalein.

He added that some of the items were found and reported by Kwajalein citizens, some were detected by EOD using a magnetometer, and one was the incident with the diver. Increasing beach erosion due to heavy westerly winds and greater wave action are exposing some UXO.

Learning to identify a UXO can be tricky. "On Kwajalein our challenge is an item could look like a pipe encrusted with some coral growth - yet that "pipe" could be a rifle grenade or bazooka, etc. The bottom line is: If you are not 100 percent sure of the item - leave it alone, report it to KPD [Kwajalein Police Department]

or call EOD," Moore said.

Many people in USAKA spend a lot of their free time beach combing, golfing and in the water. If someone comes upon an item they can't identify, they should report it. "For kids, tell an adult; others contact KPD at 911 or 54000 or EOD directly at 51433," Moore advised.

"If they [the unidentified object] are determined by EOD to be moveable and after inspection - don't pose an immediate hazard, they are then transported to our explosives bunker area for temporary storage. At predetermined times; stored UXO is taken to the island of Illegini where we have a demolition range. The UXO is placed at the demo site, explosive charges are put on top of the UXO, and EOD blows the UXO up," Moore said. He added that in the event that UXO is too dangerous to move, by EOD determination, and if it can be done safely - the UXO might be destroyed by blowing in place. "This is not an ideal situation but if it is determined it is more dangerous to try to move the UXO, then the USAKA Commander through the USAKA

Safety Office can direct EOD to do so," he said.

If the item is found underwater there's a different strategy. Underwater UXO stays in place. Kwajalein EOD only responds to surface UXO and items found on the reef during low tides. "The only authorized EOD folks who can destroy underwater UXO around Kwajalein are Navy EOD folks from the Explosives Ordnance Disposal Mobile Unit 5 out of Guam. If underwater UXO poses an immediate threat to people, property or the environment, then again, the USAKA Commander could authorize EODMU-5 to come and destroy it," Moore said.

Known underwater UXO and information on where it is located is marked on maps, Global Positioning System coordinates are taken, and information is given to mariners and divers. Some of the local wrecks and ships around Kwajalein Atoll contain UXO and dangerous cargoes.

"On Kwajalein, UXO information for children is provided on an annual basis. A part of the Army Safety Program is informing Soldiers, civilians and families who live or work on military installations about UXO awareness and education. Kwajalein Range Services, USAKA and Host Nations provided UXO awareness training to the school children on En-nubirr on April 12, to Kwajalein children grades K-6 on April 28 and to the High School students on Thursday," Moore said.

UXO safety information is also provided during the Island Orientation; all divers must view a UXO safety video, UXO information is on Page 5-28 in the 2005 Kwajalein Telephone and Island Directory, is located on the last page of the tan, tri-fold, Kwajalein Atoll Community Safety Guide brochure and is mentioned in other employee safety briefs. The KRS EOD at 51433 or the KRS or USAKA Safety Offices can always be contacted to set up UXO safety presentations or provide additional information for Kwajalein Atoll residents.

Times gone by

Movie stars, near drownings, other mayhem

During the 1944-45 war time era, Kwajalein played host to many movie stars and theatrical performers. Some were well-known celebrities while many were to earn their stardom in later years. All of these wonderful people gave the island morale a big lift with their performances at the various theaters around Kwajalein, Ebeye and Roi. The United Service Organization, Hollywood, and Broadway shows came to the islands on an almost weekly basis during 1944 through 1947. There were so many funny incidents, and a few not-so-funny happenings, that came out of those many stage shows at the Richardson; I started collecting a story here or a remembrance there about those colorful times. Since we all like to play a little trivia now and then, I'll relate a few of the tales and you can see how far back you can remember.

1. Who was the famous actor that almost drowned in the Kwajalein Lagoon during a visit by his ship during WWII? I'll give you a couple of hints. He was a Naval Officer on active duty in a real-life role similar to the one he was to later portray on the stage and in the movie "Mr. Roberts." Need another hint? He gained notoriety for playing the leading parts in the John Steinbeck story "Grapes of Wrath" in 1940. Give up? He won the Academy Award opposite Katherine Hepburn in 1982. Okay you got it. It was Henry Fonda.

In 1944 the USS Curtis visited Kwajalein. The young Air Intelligence Officer, named Henry Fonda, wished to visit a friend on the USS Mackinaw that was anchored far out in the Kwajalein Lagoon. Fonda requested a water taxi from the Ebeye Motor Boat Pool to





take him out to the USS Mackinaw. The Ebeye Boat Pool Officer, Lt. Samuel Dees, personally escorted a small boat to the USS Curtis, picked up Fonda and set out for the USS Mackinaw. Fonda conducted his business on the USS Mackinaw and later the water taxi with Dees, Fonda and two seamen along with the boats coxswain were soon headed back for the USS Curtis. About half way back towards Kwajalein, one of those heavy line squalls came up blanketing the lagoon with heavy rain and high winds. The sea became very rough and the small boat soon began to take in water over the bow.

While the coxswain fought to keep the bow into the wind, the seamen started using their hats to bail out the sea water after the bilge pumps failed. Water was rapidly filling the boat. Fonda and Dees hung onto the gunwales and anything that would float while the coxswain struggled with the boat's wheel. After bouncing around in the rough seas for almost an hour, a radio message from a bigger ship activated a rescue party from Ebeye. The rescue crew got the small boat hull tied off just as the craft rolled under the waves. They soon had Fonda and the crew back along side the USS Curtis. A very wet and cold Fonda was delivered on board.

2. Who was the young female singer and movie star that received a personal apology from the Commanding Officer of Kwajalein? Need a hint? She often appeared in USO and

Hollywood shows that also starred a famous comedian. Give up? She later was a member of the cast and

the featured singer of a weekly radio show that starred this same comedian. Last hint. She appeared in the movie version of "This is The Army" in 1943 and later starred in movies like "The Glenn Miller Story," "Hollywood Hotel" and "People are Funny." By now you must have guessed, Frances Langford.

It seems that Langford was invited to visit Ebeye after she appeared in a stage show at the Richardson with Bob Hope. According to my sources, she and some of the other performers ended up at the officer's club.

3. Who was the famous actor who brought a Major League Baseball team to Kwaj in 1945? This should be easy for all you sports fans. Need a hint? He was a child actor in the 1930s long before Shirley Temple, Jane Withers or Roddy McDowell. His more famous child roles were in "Little Rascals," "The Champ," "Treasure Island" and "Hollywood on Parade." Still stuck? The child actor later became even more well known as he portrayed adult roles in the four big Superman pictures, "Return of Frank James" and "The Quest for Peace." Hopefully by now you will remember my childhood hero, Jackie Cooper.

In February of 1945, a group made up of Major League Baseball players put on an exhibition game at Kwajalein. The roster of players included just about every well known major league star of the times. While this writer doesn't remember the eventual ending score of the exhibition game, I do

remember there was a six-inning pre-game between some of the professional players and a team made up from Kwajalein's finest baseball players. I recall the score but I won't repeat that score either. It was a great moral builder talked about on island for many weeks afterward.

Global War on Terror

Honoring fallen heroes

The following 19 U.S. servicemembers and civilians have died in the Global War on Terrorism.

Staff Sgt. William J. Brooks, 30, of Birmingham, Ala., died May 3 in Baghdad, Iraq, when his unit was conducting a route security mission and an improvised explosive device detonated near his HMMWV. Brooks was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 64th Armor Regiment, 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, Ga.

Petty Officer Third Class Jeffery L. Wiener, 32, of Louisville, Ky., died May 7, in a combat related incident. Wiener was a Navy hospital corpsman assigned to II Marine Expeditionary Force.

Three Marines died May 7 while conducting combat operations in Al Anbar Province, Iraq. Died were: **Sgt. Aaron N. Cepeda Sr.**, 22, San Antonio, **Lance Cpl. Lance T. Graham**, 26, San Antonio and **Lance Cpl. Michael V. Postal**, 21, Glen Oaks, N.Y. Cepeda and Graham were assigned to Marine Forces Reserve's 3rd Battalion, 25th Marine Regiment, 4th Marine Division, San Antonio, as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom their unit was attached to 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force (Forward). Postal was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 8th Marine Regiment, 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Lejeune, N.C.

Lance Cpl. Lawrence R. Philippon, 22, of Hartford, Conn., died Sunday from enemy small-arms fire while conducting combat operations in the vicinity of Al Qa'im, Iraq. He was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 2nd Marine Regiment, 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force.

Two Marines died supporting Operation Iraqi Freedom. **Sgt. Michael A. Marzano**, 28, of Greenville, Pa., died May 7 as the result of an explosion caused by suicide vehicle borne improvised explosive device while conducting combat operations in Hadithah, Iraq. **Cpl. Dustin A. Derga**, 24, of Columbus, Ohio, died Sunday as the result of enemy small arms fire while conducting combat operations in Ubaydi, Iraq. Both Marines were assigned to Marine Forces Reserve's 3rd Battalion, 25th Marine Regiment, 4th Marine Division. Marzano's company is based in Phoenix, and Derga's company is based Columbus, Ohio. As part of Operation Iraqi Freedom their unit was attached to 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force (Forward).

Cpl. Richard P. Schoener, 22, of Hayes, La., died Sunday in Alishang, Afghanistan, while conducting combat operations. He was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, 3rd Marine Division, III Marine Expeditionary Force, Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii.

Sgt. Gary A. Eckert Jr., 24, of Toledo, Ohio, died Sunday in Balad, Iraq, from injuries sustained earlier that day in Samarra, Iraq, when

an improvised explosive device detonated near his HMMWV. Eckert was assigned to the Army Reserve's 983rd Engineer Battalion, Monclova, Ohio.

Two Soldiers **Staff Sgt. Thor H. Ingraham**, 24, of Murrysville, Pa. and **Pfc. Nicolas E. Messmer**, 20, of Franklin, Ohio, died Sunday in Khalidiyah, Iraq, when they were conducting combat operations and an improvised explosive device detonated near their HMMWV. Both were assigned to the 1st Battalion, 506th Infantry Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Greaves, Korea.

Lance Cpl. Nicholas C. Kirven, 21, of Richmond, Va., was killed Sunday as a result of enemy action in Alishang, Afghanistan, while conducting combat operations. He was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, 3rd Marine Division, III Marine Expeditionary Force, Kaneohe Bay.

Two Marines, **Pfc. Stephen P. Baldwyn**, 19, of Saultillo, Miss. and **Lance Cpl. Taylor B. Prazynski**, 20, of Fairfield, Ohio, died Monday. Baldwyn died as a result of wounds received from an explosion while conducting combat operations against enemy forces in Nasser Wa Salaam, Iraq. Prazynski died from an explosion while conducting combat operations against enemy forces in Al Karmah, Iraq.

Marine Staff Sgt. Anthony L. Goodwin, 33, of Mount Holly, N.J., died Monday from enemy small-arms fire while conducting combat operations in the vicinity of Al Qaim, Iraq. He was assigned to 2nd Marine Regiment, 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Lejeune.

Lance Cpl. Marcus Mahdee, 20, of Fort Walton Beach, Fla., died Monday as a result of wounds received from an enemy explosion while conducting combat operations in the vicinity of Al Karmah, Iraq. He was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 8th Marine Regiment, 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Lejeune.

1st Sgt. Michael J. Bordelon, 37, of Morgan City, La., died Tuesday at Brooke Army Medical Center, San Antonio, from injuries sustained April 23 in Mosul, Iraq, when a vehicle-borne improvised explosive device detonated near his Stryker military vehicle. Bordelon was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 24th Infantry Regiment, 1st Brigade, 25th Infantry Division (Stryker Brigade Combat Team), Fort Lewis, Wash.

Lance Cpl. Wesley G. Davids, 20, of Dublin, Ohio, died Wednesday from an explosion while conducting combat operations against enemy forces in Karabilah, Iraq. He was assigned to Marine Forces Reserve's 3rd Battalion, 25th Marines, 4th Marine Division, Columbus, Ohio. During Operation Iraqi Freedom, his reserve unit was attached to 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force (Forward).



Appointment of part-time U.S. Magistrate Judge

The Judicial Conference of the United States has authorized the appointment of a part-time United States magistrate judge for the United States District Court for the District of Hawaii at Kwajalein Missile Range.

The duties of the position are demanding and wide-ranging, and include: (1) the conduct of most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases; (2) the trial and disposition of misdemeanor cases; (3) the conduct of various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from the judges of the district court; and (4) the trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of the litigants. The basic authority of a United States magistrate judge is specified in 28 U.S.C. Section 636.

To be qualified for appointment an applicant must:

(1) Be, and have been for at least five years, a member in good standing of the bar of the highest court of a state, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Territory of Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, or the Virgin Islands

of the United States, and have been engaged in the active practice of law for a period of at least five years (with some substitutes authorized), or have a degree from a college or university of recognized standing, with a minimum of five years of progressively responsible administrative experience in public service or business;

(2) Be competent to perform all the duties of the office; be of good moral character; be emotionally stable and mature; be committed to equal justice under the law; be in good health; be patient and courteous; and be capable of deliberation and decisiveness;

(3) Be less than 70 years old;
(4) Not be related to a judge of the district court; and
(5) Reside on Kwajalein.

A merit selection panel composed of attorneys and other members of the community will review all applicants and recommend to the judges of the district court in confidence the five persons it considers best qualified. The court will make the appointment following an FBI full-field investigation and an IRS tax check of the applicant selected

by the court for appointment. An affirmative effort will be made to give due consideration to all qualified applicants, including women and members of minority groups. The current annual salary of the position is \$3,753. The term of office is four years. More information on the magistrate judge position may be obtained from the Clerk of the U.S. District Court or the chairperson of the selection panel.
