

# A history lesson to be learned, pondered

In late 1952, the Korean War had reached a stalemate. The Chinese, North Koreans and the American-led United Nations forces opposing them had built such strong defensive lines that neither side could launch an offensive without terrible losses.

Peace negotiations were taking place at Panmunjom. The Chinese did all they could to make the talks tedious and exasperating.

Their goal was to stretch negotiations out as long as

possible, keep the war going and break the United States and its allies' fortitude and willingness to stay and keep defending South Korea.

To gain leverage in the talks in March, 1953, the Chinese decided to launch a massive attack.

The place they picked for the assault was a series of barren, relatively unimportant hills, lightly held by U.S., Thai, Columbian and South Korean troops. One piece of that high ground was designated on United Nations'


maps as Hill 255.

Today, history knows it as Pork Chop Hill.

The Chinese plan was simple. They would accept heavy casualties in order to inflict heavy casualties and thereby break the resolve of the Americans and their allies.

On March 23, 1953, after an 8,000 round artillery barrage, two Chinese divisions attacked Pork Chop Hill.

The defenders were driven back with heavy losses, but



counterattacked and regained the hill. The hill next to Pork Chop (Old Baldy) was held by Columbian troops. They fought bravely but couldn't hold against

**A Christmas Story**, Nine years after the Yuletide slasher flick *Black Christmas*, *Porky's* director Bob Clark once again took on the holiday genre, switching from gasps to laughs with *A Christmas Story*. Adapted from a memoir by humorist Jean Shepherd (who narrates), the film centers on Ralphie Parker (Peter Billingsley), a young boy living in 1940s Indiana, desperately yearning for a Red Rider BB gun for Christmas. Despite protests from his mother (Melinda Dillon) that he'll shoot his eye out, Ralphie persists, unsuccessfully trying to enlist the assistance of both his teacher and Santa Claus. All the while, Ralphie finds himself dealing with the constant taunts of a pair of bullies and trying to not get in the middle of a feud between his mother and father (Darren McGavin) regarding a sexy lamp.

**Miracle on 34<sup>th</sup> Street**, Edmund Gwenn plays Kris

Kringle, a bearded old gent who is the living image of Santa Claus. Serving as a last-minute replacement for the drunken Santa who was to have lead Macy's Thanksgiving Parade, Kringle is offered a job as a Macy's toy-department Santa. Supervisor Maureen O'Hara soon begins having second thoughts about hiring Kris: it's bad enough that he is laboring under the delusion that he's the *genuine* Saint Nick; but when he begins advising customers to shop elsewhere for toys that they can't find at Macy's, he's gone too far! Amazingly, Mr. Macy (Harry Antrim) considers Kris' shopping tips to be an excellent customer-service "gimmick," and insists that the old fellow keep his job. A resident of a Manhattan retirement home, Kris agrees to take a room with lawyer John Payne during the Christmas season. It happens that Payne is sweet on O'Hara, and Kris subliminally hopes he can bring the two together. .



overwhelming numbers.

When Old Baldy fell, Pork Chop should have been abandoned. But the Americans came to realize what the Chinese were doing. And so Pork Chop was to be held at all costs.

Attack and counterattack followed. The Chinese kept pouring fresh troops into the battle. American regiments kept arriving to join the fight and hold the ground.

On April 18, the Chinese made one

more assault before finally giving up and withdrawing.

But the peace talks broke down once more and on July 6, Chinese divisions attacked Pork Chop again in another effort to break American spirit.

The Americans were driven from the hill but in yet another counterattack regained the summit at a very high cost.

There were political repercussions in the United States about the high casualties sustained for strategically

unimportant ground.

But many believe the resolve shown by the U.S. military and its willingness to accept casualties, convinced the Chinese and North Koreans that they could not break the American will to fight and they finally negotiated seriously and put an end to the war.

The lesson of Pork Chop hill should not be lost on Americans today. Once again, Americans have to show our enemies our resolve and the will to win.


