

# It's not what you do, it's how you do it

Like all baseball fans, I've seen what's happened in stadiums this season whenever Barry Bonds has come to bat.

In every city except San Francisco, he's been booed and jeered. Signs are everywhere saying 'cheater' and 'juiced.' I saw another huge sign that read 'Ruth did it with beer and hot dogs, Aaron did it with CLASS, what did YOU do it with?'

Now Bonds has tied Babe Ruth and he'll hit that 715th home run to pass 'the Babe' any day now, perhaps even as this goes to print. But outside of the bay area, I don't think many baseball fans will give a hoot.

Why are the fans and the baseball world reacting that way to Bonds? He's one of the best to ever play the game. Certainly it's the possibility that he's cheated by using steroids. But I think there's a lot more to it than that.

I think it would be a much different scene if it was someone like Ken Griffey, Jr. or perhaps someday, Albert Pujols, passing 'the Babe.' They would be cheered on.

I was around when Henry Aaron was chasing Ruth's record. Aaron was a black ballplayer at a time when blacks were still not allowed in white hotels, restaurants or toilets in many areas of the country. He endured the racial prejudice and hatred that was rife in America then. He was booed and treated terribly in some of the cities he played in. He received death threats when he got closer and closer to breaking Ruth's (white America's hero) home run record.

The thought of that happening was an abomination to millions of white baseball fans.

But Aaron prevailed through it all. He later said, "When I was in a ballpark, I felt like I was surrounded by angels, and had God's hand on my shoulder."

On April 8, 1974, at Atlanta-Fulton County Stadium, a sellout crowd of 53,775 and a nationwide TV audience watched as Aaron came to bat in the bottom of the fourth inning against the Dodgers. He swung at a 1-0 pitch and hit a line drive over the 385 foot mark in left-center field for his 715th home run, breaking Ruth's record of 714.

As he rounded the bases, white players from the Dodgers team shook his hand, white fans ran on to the field to pat him on the back and celebrate with him, and fans in Atlanta and around the country cheered for him.

With his grace and dignity, Aaron won everyone's respect and acknowledgement of his prowess, and he overcame the anger many fans had toward him for breaking Ruth's record.

A smart man once told me it's not what you do, but how you do it.

It wasn't just the many things that Aaron accomplished, it wasn't just the home run record, his gold glove awards or his record 24 All-Star game appearances. It was how he did it. It was like that sign said. He did it with total class.




Landers suggested that synchronized swimming become part of the next Kwajalymphics lineup.







Meck oceanside caution area is wedge-shaped centered on Meck latitude 9N, longitude 167 43.4E.


- Meck-North Point-latitude 9 06.2N, longitude 167 47E

In conjunction with this operation, a caution area will exist within the Kwajalein Atoll starting Tuesday. The caution area is bound on the north by Boked Island on the east reef and Yabbermohr Island on the west reef. On the south, the area is bounded by a line drawn north of Bigej Island on the east reef to a point at latitude 08 54.2N, longitude 167 45.8E, then

to a point at latitude 08 52.8N, longitude 167 45.8E and then to a point north of the high tide mark on Ninni Island on the west reef. Bigej Island, including the inner reef, is specifically excluded and is not part of the mid-atoll corridor.


In order to ensure clearance of nonmission support personnel from the mid-atoll corridor by the window opening time, Kwajalein Police Department island clearing procedures will continue until evacuation has been accomplished. Egress of all air and seacraft will be required when requested by authorized clearance personnel. Subsequent to lagoon clearance, the hazard area will be in effect until mission completion.
