If I was one of those astronauts they'd have to drag me kicking and screaming to get in that thing.


I'd be looking through *USAjobs*.

I hope this 'calculated risk' turns out better than the last one.





COL Stipe talks about her time on Kwaj

In the U.S. Army Kwajalein command conference room there are a series of pictures showing the past commanders of Kwajalein Atoll dating from 1964. In just a few short weeks, another picture will reside on that wall; the one of COL Beverly Stipe, the present commander.

Stipe is set to pass command to Col. Stevenson Reed on Tuesday.

Though Stipe will no longer be on island, evidence of her many contributions to the Kwajalein mission and community will remain.

Q. What did you enjoy the most about your tour in Kwajalein?

A. "The missions are fantastic and the extra-curricular activities also provided plenty to do, even when all I wanted to do was nothing. In 26 years, I have never been associated with such a diverse and eclectic group of Soldiers, DA [Department of the Army] civilians and a contractor workforce. One thing did affect me more than anything else ... the kids. Young kids, middle and high school kids, and kids returning from college. Marshallese kids and American kids alike. Kwajalein may be a national asset, and to some a national treasure, but the kids are our future. Many know that I kept track of the kids who found themselves in a little trouble. I don't regret my involvement in their lives because I found that with a little attention and direction, I seemed to make an impact. I built strong relationships with plenty of the high school juniors and seniors this year, and let me tell you, we have some amazingly smart kids here. And they challenged me. At graduation, the seniors provide the commander with a small token of their 'appreciation'. Last year I received 16 miniature bugle pins. You can guess why. This year, I received pictures of each of the seniors on 'get out of jail free' cards. You can also guess why. I will keep those special memories forever. At the Christmas tree lighting ceremonies, I recall the little kids dancing and singing and waving to Santa and the elves. I remember the one special little boy, Gannon, who impressed me so with

his questions right before Christmas that I had to mention him in my remarks. And I recall very well the little Marshallese child from Ennibur, who, after a day's worth of activities, decided that my lap was the most comfortable and he was just going to climb up and take a short nap. He ended up helping me light the Roi tree this year. Very special memories...and the kids, from the youngest to the oldest, made them extraordinary."

Q. You spent your time as commander without your spouse. What advice would you give the incoming commander as well as any other individual living on Kwajalein without their spouse?

A. "Well, there was definitely a void here for me. But as a Soldier, I have become used to family separations. Gary and I have suffered through 13 years of separation over my 26-year career. It is never easy, and I find that as I get closer to the point where Gary will let me retire, it gets harder. For us, we busied ourselves with raising three great kids, and the separations were managed. When they left home and it was just the two of us, as empty-nesters we finally knew the feeling of what true happiness really is...that last tuition payment. But as we are older now, the separations are harder. This is the time we should be enriching our relationship with each other, and deciding what we want to do with the rest of our lives. The perception on Kwajalein is that the spouse of the commander cannot work on Kwajalein because that spouse might influence command decisions...and if the spouse works for the contractor that could be a major problem. Gary is an electrical engineer. He would have been easily employed here, but with the perception of the conflict of interest and our desire to continue building our retirement capital (and my desire not to have him sit around and get lazy), we decided that he would reoccupy our Virginia home and wait for me. In my case, I knew I would only have to be separated for two years, and I knew that with Gary in Virginia, I would likely be able to see him often, as I was called back to the

area by the headquarters. We adjusted well to that. For anyone else, I have no real advice except to bring your spouse if at all possible."

Q. Any suggestions for improvement?

A. "If there is a way to eliminate the need for the perception of a conflict of interest so that a commander's spouse or any spouse for that matter would not influence the decision-making process, I haven't found a way to do it."

Q. What is the one thing you wished you could've done while you were here?

A. "What I really wanted is happening right now. When you ride up Ocean and you don't see that badly deteriorating PBQ, my mission will be complete. Jerry Brown told me that several commanders have tried to secure funding for renovation or demolition of this poor, tired building, and every time they thought they had the answer, someone, somewhere would move the funds for a higher priority. We are at war and while I understand that priority, I also understand the need to remove an eyesore. The PBQ is coming down, and in its place will reside a new headquarters building. So to answer the question, I guess I did everything I wanted to do, and I left everything that I couldn't do. There will be no shortage of projects for Colonel Reed and the staff to wrestle with, but there won't be the same financial struggles that landed squarely on my command tour."

Q. How would you like the residents of Kwajalein to remember you?

A. "I hope the community knows I always tried to be fair...with my

Leading the festivities was the not-to-be-missed bicycle parade. Pint-sized cyclists proudly rode their decked out rides dripping with red, white and blue patriotism past a cheering crowd of family and friends.

Amber Banducci kicked off the festivities,

wowing the crowd with her version of the national anthem, followed by a brief keynote speech by COL Beverly Stipe, U.S. Army Kwajalein Atoll commander.

Stipe set a patriotic tone for the day as she recounted the story of how Francis Scott Key was inspired to write that star-spangled

the land of the free and the home of the brave.” She reminded the crowd how these words rang true following the attacks on the United States on 9/11. And she reminded us that the flag is more than just a Fourth of July decoration.

“We love the Fourth of July here, we love it better than in the States,” said Loretta Childers. “Here we have all these organized activities, the beach, the games. Last year we went home to the states and my kids were bored to death.”

Boredom was not an option where the Kwajalein Range Services Community Activities team was concerned. “We want to do it up right, and make it a special day for the community to remember,” explained Simone Smead, Community Activities manager.

All day long children tumbled in and out of the inflatable bounce house, and with wobbly legs headed to the carnival games to try their hand at winning a prize or two.

The family favorite egg toss competition and a heat busting ride on the banana boat scored big with the age 10 and over crowd. This was a celebration filled with bingo, beach volleyball, kayak races and even a bit of shopping courtesy of the commercial vendor tents set up throughout the venue.

Highlighting this year’s Beach Blast were two new features, the Water Slide and Baggo – designed

Taking care

Pregnant women can pass Group B Strep to fetus

July is "Group B Strep Awareness Month," designated to help inform women of the need to get screened for GBS during pregnancy.


According to the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, GBS can be found in up to 40 percent of pregnant women.

A woman with GBS can pass it on to her fetus when she is pregnant or to her baby during delivery or after birth. Despite a 70 percent decline in incidence during the past decade, early-onset GBS remains a leading cause of infectious disease among newborn. In 2002, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention updated its GBS prevention guidelines to recommend universal prenatal screening for vaginal and rectal group B strep colonization of all pregnant women at 35-37 weeks' gestation. GBS carriage can be detected during pregnancy by taking a swab of both the vagina and rectum for special culture.

A positive culture result means that the mother carries GBS — not that she or her baby will definitely become ill. Women who carry GBS should not be given oral antibiotics before labor because antibiotic treatment at this time does not prevent GBS disease in newborns. An exception to this is when GBS is identified in urine during pregnancy. GBS in the urine should be treated at the time it is diagnosed. Carriage of GBS, in either the vagina or rectum, becomes important at the time of labor and delivery — when antibiotics are effective in preventing the spread of GBS from mother to baby.

GBS can cause severe infection in newborns, including sepsis, meningitis, and pneumonia. The majority of infections in newborns occur within the first week of life. Infected infants may have long-term neurological problems such as vision or hearing impairment or developmental delays. Overall, 6.5 percent of infected full-term newborns and 22.7 percent of infected pre-term infants die from complications of GBS.

Cause was named for a couple whose son Jesse was born with GBS. GBS caused meningitis, sepsis and hydrocephalus, resulting in three brain surgeries. The Jesse Cause was founded in hopes of sparing other families the devastating effects of GBS. Their Web site offers a wealth of resources on GBS for medical professionals, expectant parents, and families affected by GBS.

Inside Man - The volatile showdown between a determined cop and a perfectionist bank robber is sent spiraling toward disaster when a scheming power broker steps in to take control of the situation in this hair-raising heist flick directed by Spike Lee and starring Denzel Washington, Clive Owen and Jodie Foster. Dalton Russell (Owen) is a bank robber with a difference. Dalton's uncanny ability of staying one step ahead of the law thwarts even-tempered Detective Keith Frazier's (Washington) best efforts. But there's another factor at play. The bank president has requested the services of high-profile negotiator Madeline White (Foster). Despite her commendable track record, Madeline is something of a wild card, and before the day is over, this bank robbery will go down in history as one of the most elaborate heists ever executed.

Stay Alive - A group of teens discover that the next generation of survival horror games are more realistic than they thought when they begin dying in the same manner as their pixelated counterparts. In the days following the mysterious death of an old friend, a young group of gaming enthusiasts comes into possession of a chillingly realistic game based on the exploits of a 17th century noblewoman who earned the name 'The Blood Countess' for her murderous exploits.

Glory Road - A true-life story of a basketball team who broke down barriers while racking up victories is the basis for this sports drama. Don Haskins (Josh Lucas) was a high school and college basketball star who, after six years of working with high school teams, became the head coach at Texas Western University in 1962. At that time, Texas Western's basketball program was not well respected, but Haskins was determined to change that, and in 1966 Haskins assembled what he was certain was a winning team. However, Haskins' team was comprised entirely of African-American athletes at a time when racially integrated teams were still a novelty in the South and West. Despite generating a firestorm of controversy, Haskins and his players showed they could succeed where it counted — on the court. In post-season play Haskins and the Texas Western team found themselves competing for the NCAA championship against the University of Kentucky's all-white team, lead by legendary coach Adolph Rupp (Jon Voight).

Pfc. Michael J. Potocki, 21, of Baltimore, died on June 26, of injuries sustained in Al Asad, Iraq, when his unit came in contact with enemy force's small arms fire during combat operations. Potocki was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 6th Infantry Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division, Baumholder, Germany.

Cpl. Jeremy S. Jones, 25, of Omaha, Neb., died on June 27 of injuries sustained from an improvised explosive device during dismantled combat operations in Baghdad, Iraq. Jones was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 67th Armored Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Hood, Texas.

Pfc. Rex A. Page, 21, of Kirksville, Mo., died June 28 from wounds received while conducting combat operations in Al Anbar province, Iraq.

He was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 5th Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division, I Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Pendleton, Calif.

Cpl. Aaron M. Griner, 24, of Tampa, Fla., died in Helmand Province, Afghanistan, on June 28, of injuries sustained when his vehicle struck a mine during combat operations. Griner was assigned to the 2nd Battalion, 87th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry), Fort Drum, N.Y.

Spc. Christopher D. Rose, 21, of San Francisco died on Thursday of injuries sustained from an improvised explosive device during combat operations in Baghdad, Iraq. Rose was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 67th Armored Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Hood, Texas.

Sgt. Bryan C. Luckey, 25, of Tampa, Fla., died on Thursday, in Mosul, Iraq, when he was shot by enemy forces while on mounted patrol. Luckey was assigned to the 562nd Engineer Company, 172nd Stryker Brigade Combat Team, Fort Wainwright, Alaska.



Taxi!

Protestant Chapel puts fleet of 'taxi' bikes in service for use by anyone who needs a ride

Starting this week Kwajalein will be home to a free taxi bicycle service courtesy of the Island Memorial Chapel.

"Sometimes people are in need of a bike, sometimes their bike breaks down and they need one," said the Rev. Rick Funk, protestant chaplain, "and wouldn't it be nice if they had one to use."

By the end of this week 21 bicycle taxis will be available at the airport, dock security check point, the chapel and the Corlett Recreation Center for the borrowing.

Modeled after the New York City Yellow Cab, these bicycles are painted taxi cab yellow and are marked with the snazzy checkerboard design and the word 'taxi' boldly painted on the side.

"It's a taxi," Funk said, "typically you take a taxi one way, so there is that potential that when you come out the taxi might not be there, someone else has used it."

When the bicycles break down or are no longer serviceable the borrower should notify the chapel or return the bicycle to the chapel. The chapel congregation is responsible for the maintenance and will work to put the bicycle back in action.

The chapel staff asks that the bicycles are not modified in any way, and that borrowers not lock up the bicycles or store them in the housing areas.

to the chapel when they realized that they had a fleet of temporary duty-use bicycles that they no longer needed. They approached the chapel and the bike taxi service was put into action.

"I hope that the community takes to the idea," said Funk, "that it becomes a community asset. It's a fun idea."
